

If you wish to serve alcohol at the Plainfield Town Hall Opera House, you, or the caterer who is serving alcohol, must have liquor liability coverage. Private caterers, like Positive Pie in Plainfield, have that coverage. If you decide to use a local caterer, they will need to apply for a permit to serve alcohol at your event from the Plainfield Select Board. Contact the Town Clerk, Linda Wells, at 454-8461 for more information. *Note that this requires several weeks lead time.*

If you wish to provide alcohol as an individual, check with your homeowner's insurance company to see if they will provide one-day liquor liability insurance coverage for your event. If not, or if you would like to explore other options, you can obtain one-day liquor liability coverage through something called the "Tenant User Liability Insurance Policy" (TULIP). The process is pretty simple and straightforward. Click on "TULIP-Event Insurance" and "Purchase or Quote". To proceed, you will need to enter the following venue code which identifies Plainfield Town as the venue: 0406-222.

A liquor liability insurance policy for a 75-person birthday party is currently \$180.

If you decide to serve liquor as an individual, you must provide proof of your liquor liability coverage to the Booking Coordinator prior to your event. (Select Board approval will not be required).
